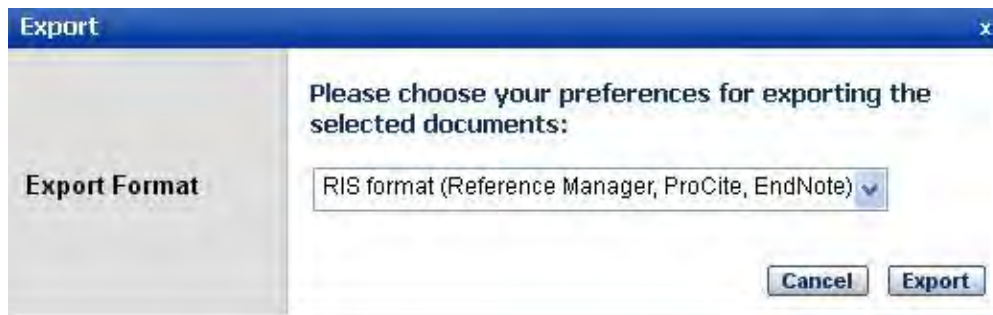


EndNote and Embase

Importing records from Embase can be done directly without the need for an EndNote filter. Citations with abstracts will be loaded into your EndNote library.

In Embase ...

- Perform a search
- Mark the citations you want to save by clicking the checkbox against the citations
- Click on **Export** in the bar above or below the results list of citations
- From the Export window, ensure the **RIS format (Reference Manager, Procite, EndNote)** is selected from the dropdown menu
- Click on **Export** button



- You are shown a Ready for Download window, click on the **Download** button
- In the Opening Records window, ensure that the Open with **ResearchSoft Direct Export Helper (default)** is selected from the dropdown menu
- Click on **OK**



In EndNote ...

- Your database records should now be loaded into the EndNote library you have open. If you don't have an EndNote library open, records will be loaded into the library you last had open.

Notes:

Always check imported citations as editing may be required.
