Jane Franklin Hall is a smoke-free campus.  
No smoking is permitted in any building or within any part of the College grounds.

Jane Franklin Hall is a College of the University of Tasmania and was founded in 1950 under the auspices of the Tasmanian Council of Churches.

The College was named after Jane, Lady Franklin, wife of Sir John Franklin, Lieutenant Governor of Van Diemen's Land (1837-1843). Its name commemorates Jane Franklin's enlightened interest in the education and welfare of women. It is also a tribute to the ideal, which she shared with her husband, for the foundation of a colonial university.

## **Welcome to Jane Franklin Hall**

### **Information for guests**

Jane Franklin Hall is a smoke-free campus. No smoking is permitted in any building or within any part of the College grounds.

We hope your stay is pleasant and comfortable. Additional information can be obtained from the office staff during normal office hours (9.00 - 4.30 Monday to Friday). Room swaps will not be made unless there are exceptional circumstances. Check out time is 10 am.

### **Summer Duty Residents (SDRs)**

On weekends, at night and on public holidays one of the SDRs is rostered on duty. Dial 200. It is expected that the SDR be called after hours only for particular difficulties that require immediate attention.

### **Tea & coffee**

Facilities are available for making tea and coffee in kitchenettes located on each floor. Please leave the kitchenette clean and tidy after you have used it.

### **Security**

The College is locked at approximately 8.30 pm every night. For access through the driveway gates and building entrances after this time, please be sure to carry your key and access card with you. Doors to bedrooms need to be kept locked in your absence. If you lock yourself out after office hours, contact the SDR. To the right of the front door of Aldridge building you will find an intercom button. Press and hold the button until the person on duty answers the duty phone, otherwise from an external phone or by mobile to phone 6210 0200.

### **Mail**

Guests' mail will be left in the alphabetical pigeonholes in the Aldridge foyer. Letters for posting may be left at the College office during office hours. Postcards, Tasmanian greeting cards and stamps are available to purchase from the office.

### **Taxi / Southern Airport door-to-door Mini Bus Service**

\$25 approximately for a single fare from Jane. If being picked up early in the morning you will need to unlock the perimeter gates then return your key to the post slot in the office door. The driver will pick you up either in Elboden or Davey Streets.

### **Car parking**

Parking is available only in the lower car park off Elboden Street. Parking is neither permitted in the kitchen service yard, nor in the College drive nor on the lawns.

### **Fire**

On arrival please read evacuation instructions in your room. Obey all fire alarms.

### **Guest Facilities**

Television with Austar channels in the Horton Common Room, free to air television – Fleming coffee lounge, Billiard Room – ground floor Barrett.

## **Telephone**

The phone in your room will not allow you to make outside calls without prior payment at the office. Payment may be made between 9.00 and 4.30 Monday to Friday.

Calls within the College are free. Dial three digits only. Room numbers and their phone extension numbers are not related. Please ask the office staff for your room extension number. To make an external call, dial **0** for an outside line and then dial the number you are calling. Do not wait for a dial tone.

The direct number for people to ring you is 62100 followed by a three digit extension number, available from the office. 100 will connect you with the office between 9.00 and 4.30 Monday to Friday. Outside office hours dial 200 for the SDR for urgent assistance.

**The emergency number (police, ambulance, fire) is 000. Remember to dial 0 first.**

The College's telephone number is 62100 100 and fax is 6224 0598.

A public telephone in the laundry is available for guests. Phone cards are also available from the office.

## **Meals**

Breakfast .....	7 - 9am
Lunch .....	12 - 1pm
Dinner .....	6 - 7 pm

Casual meals (not included in your accommodation fee) must be paid for in cash to kitchen staff.

Meal vouchers are available from the office, pre-paid by credit card, eftpos or cash.

Take out lunch -\$10 Eat in lunch -\$15 Dinner -\$20 Wine - \$18 (by the bottle) is also available to purchase from the kitchen staff.

## **Laundry**

A laundry is provided in Horton. Soap powder may be purchased at the office for \$1 per sachet.

Dry cleaning and laundry services are also available: contact the office.

## **Accounts**

Guests are asked to settle their accounts at the office before departure. Office hours are 9.00am - 4.30 pm Monday to Friday.

## **Hot water**

Beware our hot water is very hot!

## **Room servicing**

Bed linen and towels are changed weekly. These services are available Monday to Friday.

## **Shopping and services**

A small selection of shops (Post Office, supermarket, newsagent, coffee shops, restaurants and dry cleaning agent, pharmacy and pizzeria) is located at or near the corner of Elboden and Macquarie Streets.

## **Keys**

If you lose your Jane Franklin Hall key or access card, a replacement fee of up to \$100 per key will be charged. If your check out time is outside office hours please deposit your keys in the postage slot in the office door.

## **Bus service**

Buses from Franklin Square, city, Fern Tree, Cascades and Strickland Avenue go past Jane Franklin Hall on Davey and Macquarie Streets. Timetables available from the office.

## Medical Practice

The nearest medical practice is the Cascade Road Medical Centre, 30a Cascade Rd, South Hobart, Telephone: 6223 5533. Other practices are The Davey Street Medical Centre, 25 Davey Street (6223 6223) and The Grosvenor Street Medical Centre (Tel: 6224 1944) located near the University. The Royal Hobart Hospital offering 24 hour emergency service is a 10 minute ride from the College.

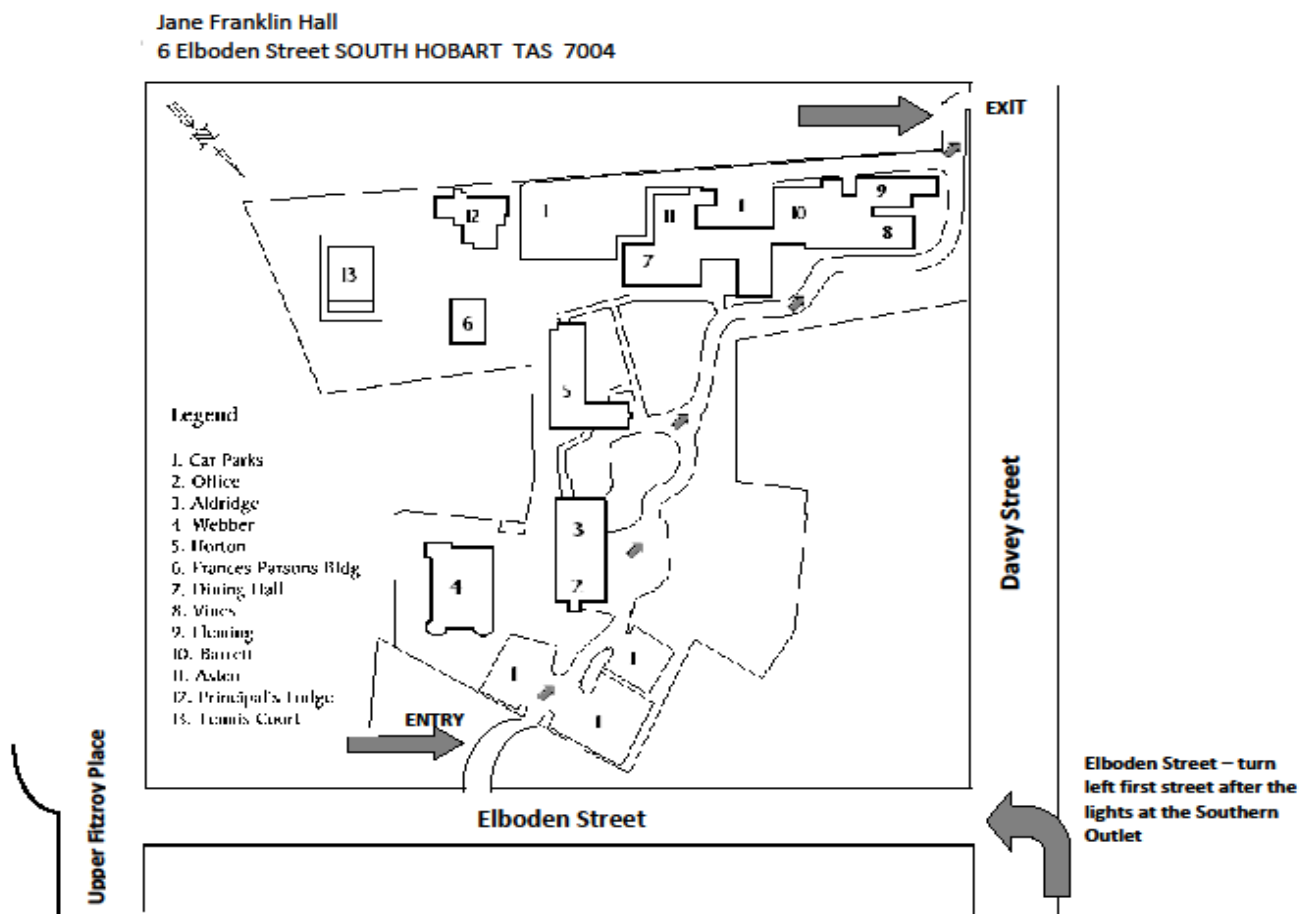
