The module takes approximately 30 minutes to complete

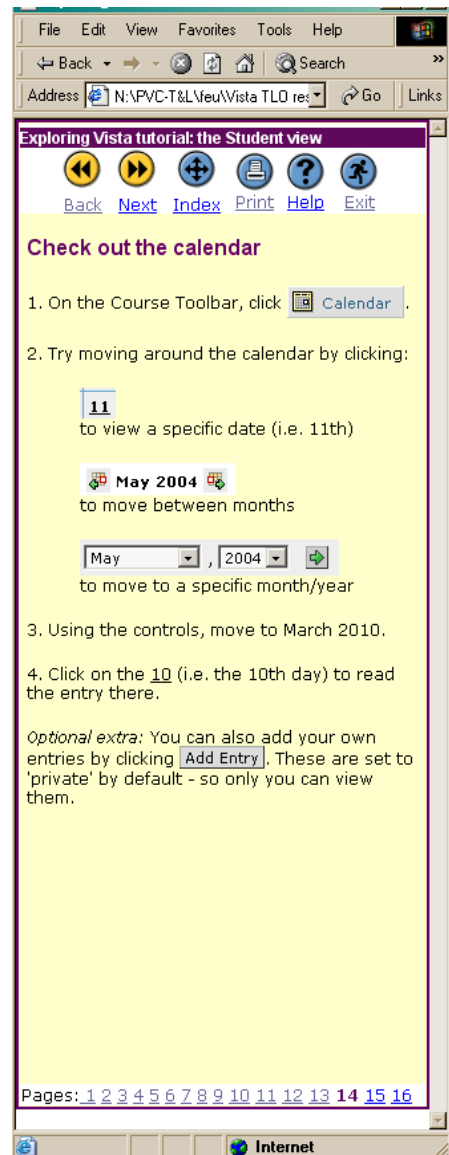
Learning requirements
