



Exploring advanced resource tools in MyLO

An online tutorial for staff

In this tutorial, we'll examine some of the tools available for adding extra content to your course. You'll use tools to set up more advanced online activities and media. This tutorial will look at some of the specific tools available to add or link audio, image and video files to your courses. You'll also create a media library for your students.

This tutorial will help you to:

- import a variety of items/content packages using the content Import tool
- import a SCORM module into your course
- integrate multimedia files from a CD-ROM or DVD, add content Files/Learning Modules using the Local Content tool
- build and manage a databank of media elements using the media library tool, link those items to content files, and otherwise manage students' access to the Media Library.

Structure and format

The tutorial is available online and is part of the module *Exploring advanced resource tools in MyLO*.

After you register you will have ongoing access to the module/tutorial and a sample course. You can access these resources at any time and undertake learning at your own pace.

The tutorial steps you through realistic scenarios. It guides you through the steps for each task as you go.

The module takes approximately 45 minutes to complete

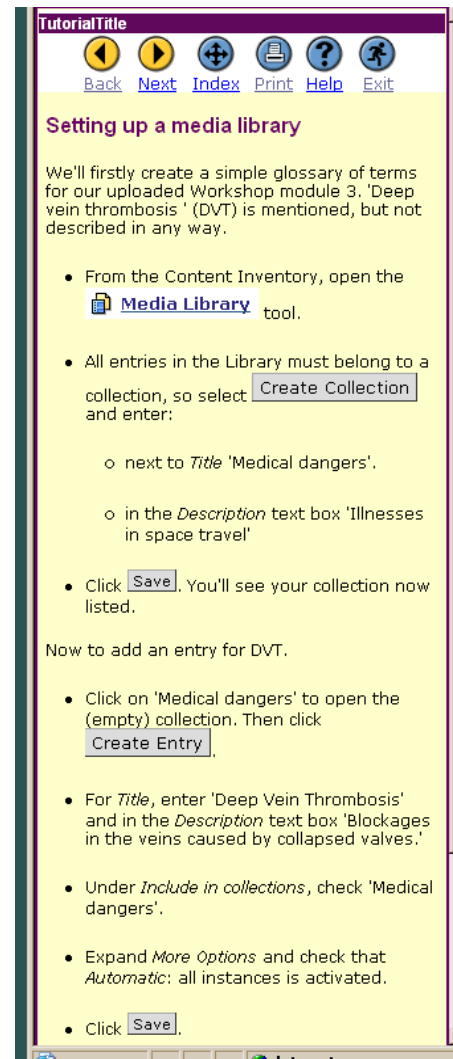
Learning requirements
