

Special Characters

HTML does not recognise special characters as you would type them with a keyboard in Word. To enter a special character, find its code from the description below and enter the code (as specified with a semi-colon at the end) in place of the character.

For example, to enter the registered trademark symbol, ®, in the title of a publication, you would enter **®** When the publication is saved, the trademark symbol will then appear in the title.
