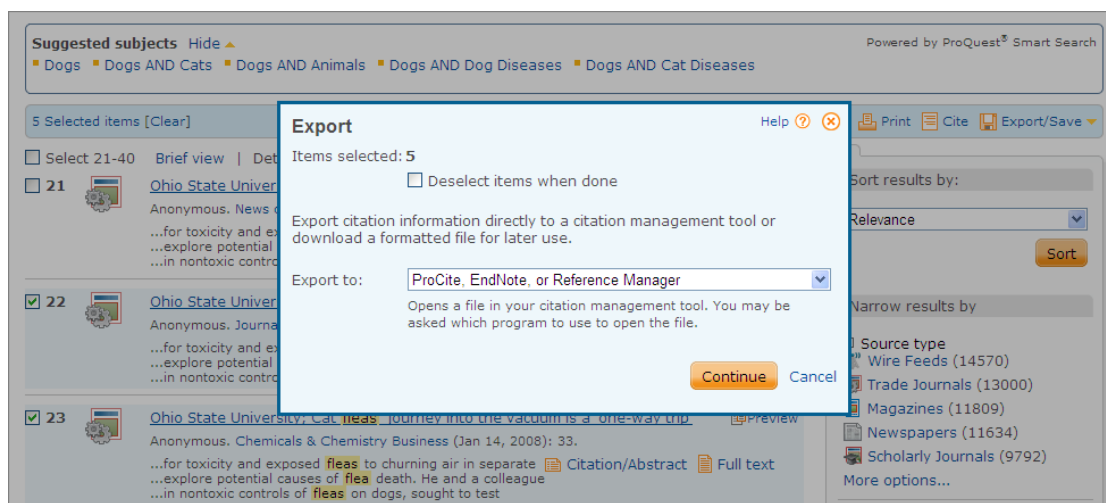


EndNote and ProQuest

Importing records from Proquest databases can be done directly without the need for an EndNote filter. Although ProQuest has fulltext articles in its database, only brief citations will be loaded into your EndNote library.

In ProQuest ...

- Perform a search.
- Mark the citations you want to save by clicking the checkbox for the title
- Click on **Export/Save** in the bar above the results
- From the drop down menu click on **ProCite, Endnote or Reference Manager**
- When the **Export** window appears click **Continue**



- When the File Download Window appears, click Open

In EndNote ...

- Your database records should now be loaded into the EndNote library you have open. If you don't have an EndNote library open, records will be loaded into the library you last had open.

Notes:

Always check imported citations as editing may be required.
