Preparing for teaching online takes the next step beyond the introductory module. We start to explore options for how to design and use online teaching effectively.

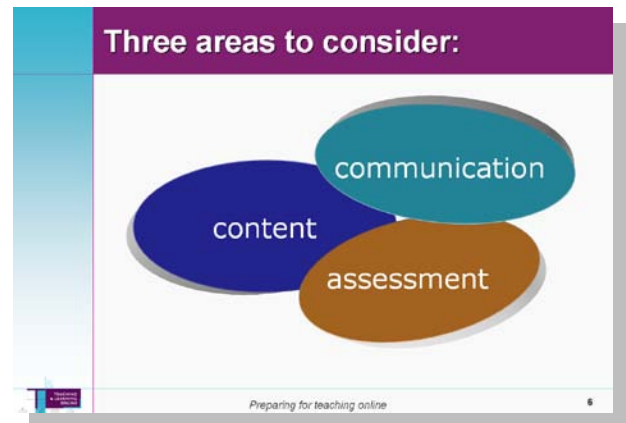
The module will help you to:
