

# EndNote and Web of Knowledge Databases

Importing records from **Web of Science, CAB Abstracts, Inspec** or **Current Contents or MEDLINE** databases can be done directly without the need for an EndNote filter.


**There are two methods of exporting records**

## Option 1 (To export records page by page)

- Perform a search within a **Web of Knowledge** database
- Mark the records you require
- Click on the **More options** link at the top of the results list to view the EndNote export options
- In the **Output Records** box at the bottom of the screen, ensure the **Selected records on page** button is selected
- Ensure that the **Authors, Title, Source** button is selected (and the **plus Abstract** checkbox if desired)
- Beside **Save to:** click the **EndNote** button.
- From the **Processing Records** screen, click the **Export** button

- Your database records should now be displayed in your EndNote library in the **Imported References** group. Always check imported citations as editing may be required.

## Option 2 (To export records from various results pages using the MARKED LIST)

- Perform a search within a **Web of Knowledge** database
- Mark the records you require
- Click on the **Add the selected records to your Marked List** icon  located above the results list or at the bottom of the page
- Click on **Marked List** link at top of the screen

On the **Marked List** page

- Select the fields you want downloaded into your EndNote library
- Click on the **Save to: EndNote** button

From the **Processing Records** screen, click the **Export** button

- Your database records should now be loaded into the EndNote library you have open. If you don't have an EndNote library open, records will be loaded into the library you last had open. Always check imported citations as editing may be required.
