



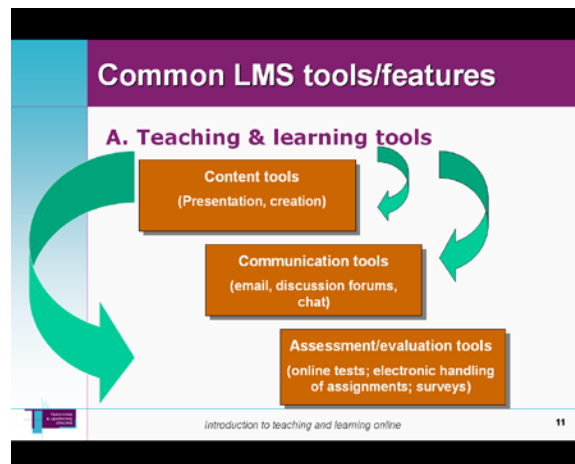
# Introduction to teaching and learning online
