

Creating quizzes and assignments

An online tutorial for staff

In this tutorial, you will create a common form of online assessment – the quiz. We choose the quiz because, by creating a quiz, you will easily be able to create the other assessment types - self tests and surveys. You will also create an assignment.

You will learn how to create content as well as learn how to set the various parameters associated with release and processing of these assessment tasks.

Structure and format

The tutorial is available online and is part of the module **Introduction to assessment online**.

The tutorial takes approximately 10 minutes to complete


Learning requirements
