

EndNote and MathSciNet


In MathSciNet ...

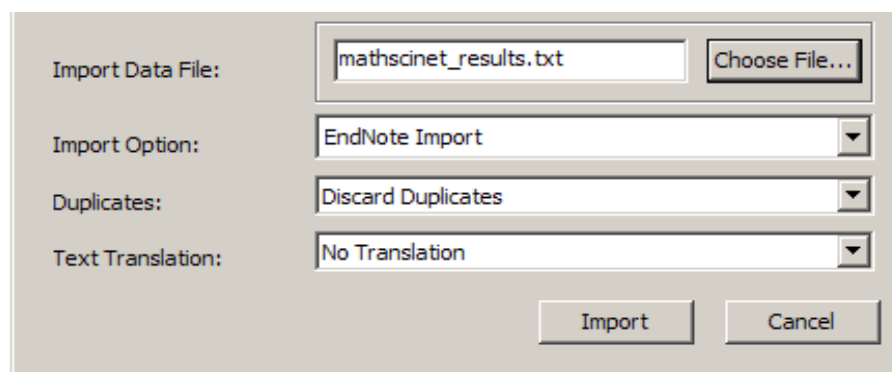
- Perform a search
- For each desired citation click on its checkbox, and click **Clipboard** for each desired citation
- Click **Clipboard** at the top of the screen
- From the **Select format:** dropdown menu select **Citations (EndNote)**.
- Click on **SaveClip** link. Your desired references are shown in coded format



- In your www browser, save the coded references under the option **Save Page As**.
- Follow your browser's prompts and create a file name, and select **Text Files** under the *Save as type:* heading

In EndNote ...

- Ensure your EndNote library is open
- Click the Import icon  or select **Import** from the **File** menu.
- An **Import** dialogue window is opened



- Click on **Choose File...** to select the text file of references
- From the **Import Option:** dropdown menu, select **EndNote Import**
- From the **Duplicates:** pull down menu, either select **Import All** or **Discard Duplicates**
- Select **No Translation** from **Text Translation:**
- Click on the **Import** button

Your database references should now be loaded into your open EndNote library. If you don't have an EndNote Library open, records will be loaded into the Library you last had open
