FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to go to orientation?

Orientation is compulsory for some schools/faculties/institutes (see guide). For everyone else it is highly recommended and is considered to be the start of your university career. Please note that all International students must attend both International sessions, as well as your Faculty session.

What time should I arrive for Orientation?

It is important that you arrive approximately 15 minutes before the scheduled start time. Please note that if you are late, your entry may be delayed.

Do I have to bring anything to orientation?

We suggest that you bring a sun hat, bottle of water, notepad and pen.

Where do I park?

If parking on campus, you must park in the designated pay-and-display voucher areas. Fines apply in other areas.

Where can I buy some food/drink?

Some sessions will include free food and drinks - this is clearly stated in the guide. Food and drinks can also be purchased from The Ref and Lazenby's.

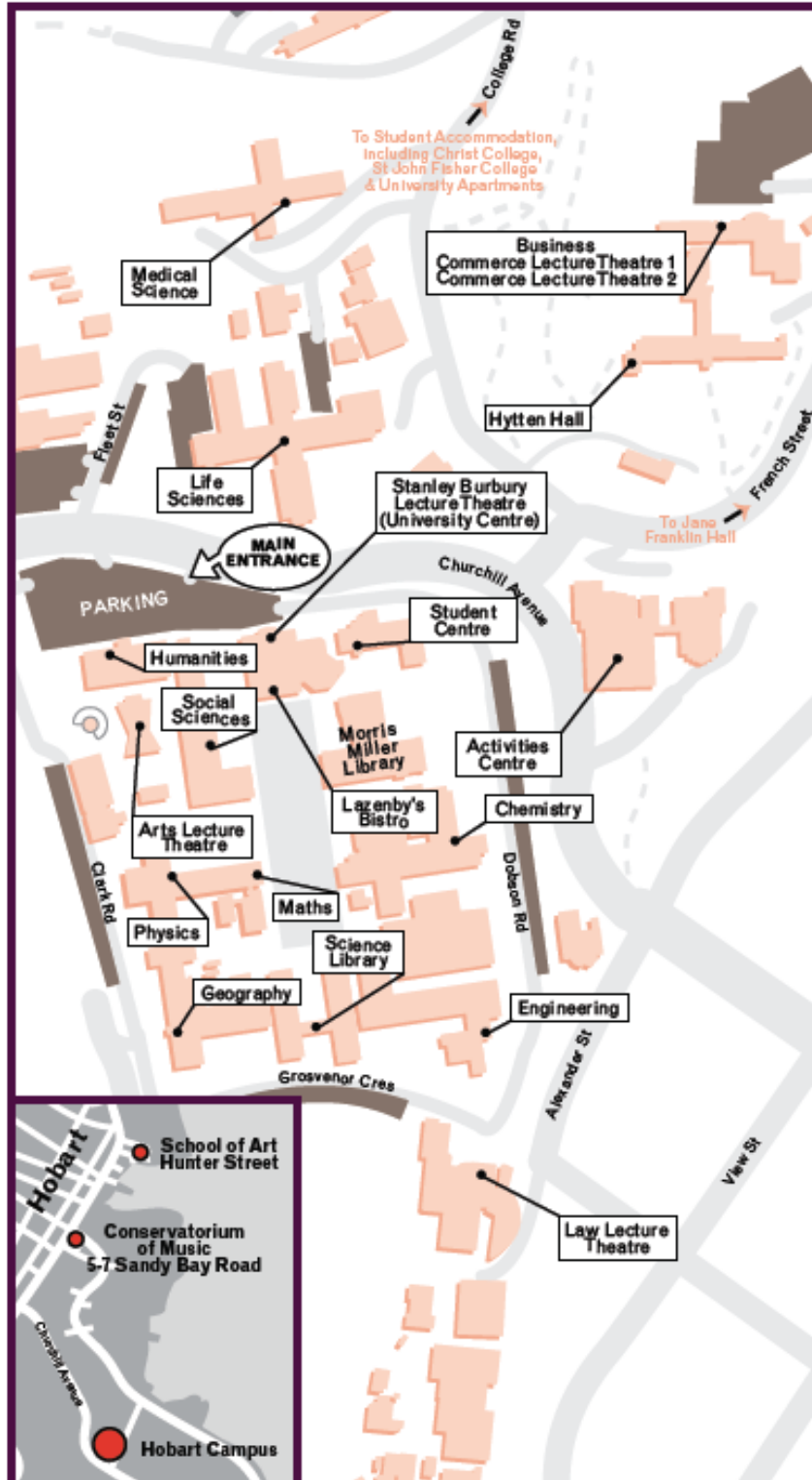
