Minimising Data Use on mobile devices

- Utilise a broadband usage counter – reset monthly from 2nd onwards
- Set email to manual retrieval
- Use Outlook Web Access (<https://owa.utas.edu.au>) instead of email client to check email



- Take advantage of eduroam when visiting Universities & CSIRO:
- (<http://www.eduroam.edu.au>)
- Avoid accessing image-intensive web sites
- Be aware of applications running in the background using up data



- Avoid opening large attachments on email unless using data free connection
- Do not loan device to other people including family/friends.



- If device lost/stolen report to Service Desk 1818 immediately – as Telstra can install a 28day temporary suspension.
- Avoid Tethering – using mobile as modem to laptop,
- if no choice have an adequate data plan.



NATIONAL USE

- All Calls FREE between University mobile-to-mobile
- Calls between Utas extensions and landlines & Utas mobiles are at standard rate.
- Utilise Free data using wifi hotspots: hotels, McDonalds etc



- Update on data usage on phones: send SMS to: 176 – text: use
- Telstra replies with an SMS
- Once exceeding your data allowance you will still operate but charged at a more expensive rate.
- Eg \$10 per 10MB, \$1,000 per 1GB



INTERNATIONAL USE

- All current plans are VOID for overseas use
- International Roaming is free must be installed for the device to work overseas – contact Service desk 1818
- Utas mobile-to-mobile free call facility is NOT available for overseas use.



- Data is very expensive, charged at standard rate:
- \$15 per MB. \$15,000 per 1GB
- Some pre-paid data plans are available for 22 selected countries – contact Service Desk, 1818



- Pre-paid Plan prices eg:

- 10MB x \$29

- 30MB x \$85

- 50MB x \$160

- Without plans:

- \$150, \$450 & \$750



- The International component of all Incoming Calls is also charged as well as Outgoing Calls.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Turn off 'Cellular Network' on the device
- Purchase pre-paid data card/sim in the country visited
- Utilise wifi hotspots & eduroam – check availability prior to travel.



- SMS is an economical option
- Skype is a cheap method if using local wifi
- If it is a must to have International Data Roaming, check to see if there is an available plan for the countries being visited - Service Desk 1818
