

# EndNote and Project MUSE

Importing records from Project MUSE can be done directly without the need for an EndNote filter.

## In Project Muse ...

- Perform a search.
- From the list of titles, select the desired records by clicking on the **Save Citation** link in the record.
- Click on **Saved Citations** in the bar on the top right hand side of the screen.

You are presented with the following **Export Saved Citations** screen.

- Saved Citations should be automatically selected for export. Select/deselect if necessary.
- Under **Option 2: EndNote**, click on **Export to EndNote**.
- When the File Download Window appears, click **Open**.

## In EndNote ....

- Your database records should now be loaded into the EndNote library you have open. If you don't have an EndNote library open, records will be loaded into the library you last had open.

Always check imported citations as editing may be required.
