

# FACULTY OF ARTS POLICY



## Off Campus Study Bursary

The Faculty of Arts is committed to providing support for students who are not able to study on-campus. A bursary of up to \$300 per year will be provided to those students who are disadvantaged due to difficulties accessing the University campuses.

### The specific aims of the bursary are:

- To provide financial assistance to those students who may be disadvantaged due to their geographical distance from the University campus, e.g. if you live more than 1 hour away by road.
- To provide financial assistance to students who have difficulty accessing the University campuses due to special circumstances. These will be considered on individual merit, e.g. due to disability, lack of public transport, family commitments, etc.
- To encourage off-campus students in their study program by off-setting some of the costs for obtaining study materials and travel expenses to attend study schools, visit the library or meeting face-to-face with lecturers.

### Those eligible to apply are students who meet the following criteria:

- Enrolled full-time or part-time in the first year of a degree offered by the Faculty of Arts at the University of Tasmania.
- Enrolled in one or more first year off-campus units taught by the Faculty of Arts at the University of Tasmania on the census date relevant to the particular semester.
- Not enrolled in any on-campus units at the University of Tasmania's Hobart or Launceston Campus.
- Not in receipt of any other scholarship or bursary.

### Eligible students may receive the following bursary:

|                   | Per semester<br>(maximum) | Per Year<br>(maximum) |
|-------------------|---------------------------|-----------------------|
| Full-time student | \$150                     | \$300                 |
| Part-time student | \$100                     | \$200                 |

Full-time students are considered to be those enrolled in 3 or more units taught by the Faculty of Arts. Part-time students are those enrolled in 1 or 2 units taught by the Faculty of Arts at the University of Tasmania.

### To apply

Applications may be submitted at any time during the semester for costs incurred for that semester's study. Payment will be made following confirmation of enrolment at the University census date.
