

To complete the BSocSc degree, you must pass 100% of units at each of level 100, 200 and 300 (meaning first, second & third year), together with two majors from the following list: Sociology, Human Resource Management, Political Science, Public Policy, Psychology or Social Ecology.

A major means sequential units in one discipline totalling 125% (normally 25% at level 100, and 100% over level 200/300). Core units will apply to HRM, Psychology, Sociology and Social Ecology majors.

**100% of first year units** - made up of 75% min of units from Schedule A, plus 25% of units from either Schedule A or elective units.

PLUS

**100% of second year units** - made up of 50% of units from one discipline for your FIRST MAJOR, plus 50% of units from another discipline for your SECOND MAJOR.

PLUS

**100% of third year units** -- made up of 50% of units from the same discipline to complete for your FIRST MAJOR, plus 50% of units from the same discipline to complete your SECOND MAJOR.
