

weighted at 25%.

To complete the BA-BSc degree, you must pass a total of 400% of units, or 100% of units in each year of the four year degree.

**In the Bachelor of Arts component you will complete 200% of units comprising:**

- 50% of first year units (level 100) from the BA schedule of units
- 50% of second year units (level 200)
- 50% of second / third year units
- 50% of third year units (level 300)
- and within the 200% of units, you must complete the requirements for at least one major (though there is room for two majors).
- A major (or specialisation) is made up of sequential units in one discipline, eg, German, comprising 25% of (German) units at level 100 (first year units) + 75%min-125%max of (German) units over level 200 / 300 (second / third year units).

**In the Bachelor of Science component you will complete:**

- At least 50% from Group 1 (first year) units listed in Schedule B which includes a combination of 25% as determined by two different subject areas;
- At least 50% from Group 2 (second year) units listed in Schedule B which includes a combination of 25% as determined by two different subjects areas;
- 50% of Group 3 (third year) units listed in Schedule B, as determined by one subject area, is completed; and
- 50% comprising a maximum of 25% from Group 1 units, a maximum of 25% from Group 2 units or a maximum of 50% from Group 3 units of the BSc schedule is completed.
