

are weighted at 25%.

**To complete the BA-BCom degree, you must pass a total of 400% of units, or 100% of units in each year of the four year degree.**

**In the Bachelor of Arts component you will complete 200% of units comprising:**

- 50% of first year units (level 100) from the BA schedule of units
- 50% of second year units (level 200)
- 50% of second / third year units
- 50% of third year units (level 300)
- and within the 200% of units, you must complete the requirements for at least one major (though there is room for two majors).
- A major (or specialisation) is made up of sequential units in one discipline, eg, German, comprising 25% of units at level 100 (first year units) + 75%min-125%max of units over level 200/300 (second / third year units).

**In the Bachelor of Commerce component you will complete:**

- 100% (8 units) of first year units, normally completed over your first and second year of study. The first year units comprise six core units and two elective units leading to the major of your choice.
- 100% (8 units) of core units for the commerce major of your choice, normally second / third year units taken over your third and fourth year of study.
