To complete the BA-BMus degree, you must pass a total of 400% of units, or 100% of units in each year of the four year degree.

In the Bachelor of Arts component you will complete 200% of units comprising:

- 50% of first year units (level 100) from the BA schedule of units
- 50% of second year units (level 200)
- 50% of second / third year units
- 50% of third year units (level 300)
- and within the 200% of units, you must complete the requirements for at least one major (though there is room for two majors).
- A major (or specialisation) is made up of sequential units in one discipline, eg, French, comprising 25% of units at level 100 (first year units) + 75%min-125%max of units over level 200/300 (second / third year units).

In the Bachelor of Music component you will complete 200% of units comprising:

- 62.5% of core Music units;
- 75% of Major Studies units;
- 25% of Music History units (Musicology students will take 37.5% of Music history);
- 50% of Music elective units (Musicology students will take 37.5% of electives).
