Use the simple guidelines on this sheet to plan your degree.

### Bachelor of Arts Structure (aka completion requirements)

- You need to pass a total of 300% of units (HECS weighting) made up of 100% at first year, 100% at second year and 100% at third year.
- And within the 300% you must complete majors (or specialisations) in **two** different disciplines, eg History and Philosophy.
- A major is made up of units in one discipline (eg History) studied over three years, totalling a minimum of 100% min eg 25% at first year and 75% at second and third year. The maximum for a major is 150%.
- At least 25% of units in each major must be Level 300 units (third year).
- You need to pass 25% of a first year discipline ie History, **before** you can enrol in the second year (History) units (unless you have TCE Stage 4 in a language with an OA or HA or equivalent).
- Of the 100% of first year units, **25%** can be a first year unit from another degree. ie, **one of**
  - Introduction to Law
  - \*Human Resource Management
  - \*Fine Arts
  - \*Music
  - \* you can continue this discipline as a major (100% maximum),

- \*Computing
- \*Marketing
- \*Tourism

## HOW TO COMPLETE A MAJOR

Majors in a BA degree are made up of 25% of first year units, plus 75% min-125% max of second/ third year units (with a minimum of 25% at third year level). Some majors have compulsory units which you must pass to complete the requirements of the major. The majors and their core units are listed below. [If you have advanced language skills, you can begin your study at second year level. You then make up your language major of 100% of second/ third year units.] **A complete list of units is contained in the 'course structure and schedule of the online 2005 Course and Unit Handbook at [www.utas.edu.au/courses/R3A](http://www.utas.edu.au/courses/R3A).**

<b>Aboriginal Studies:</b>	HAB102 and HAB103	plus 75% second/ third year units.
<b>Ancient Civilisations</b>	HTC101 and HTC102	plus 75% second/ third year units.
<b>Ancient Greek</b>	Consult with the School of History and Classics for further information.	
<b>Asian Studies</b>	HMA102 and HMA102	plus 75% second/ third year units.
<b>Chinese</b>	25% First year Chinese	plus 50% core language units at second year, plus 25% of electives.
<b>English</b>	HEA101 and HEA102 OR HEA103 and HEA104	plus 75% second/ third year units.
<b>European Studies</b>	25% from Philosophy, History, Ancient Civilisations, Government, English, French, German, Art & Design Theory as a prerequisite..	HPE201 (12.5%) plus a further 87.5% of second/ third year units and at least one unit from each of 4 lists. NOTE: The 25% from first year does not count towards the 100% of the major. The major starts at second year level.
<b>French</b>	HEF100	plus HEF201, HEF301 plus 25% second/ third year electives
<b>Gender Studies</b>	HAF101 and HAF102	plus HAF215/315 plus 62.5% second/ third year units
<b>Geography and Environmental Studies</b>	KGA100 OR KGA101	plus 75% second/ third year units.
<b>German</b>	25% First year German	plus 25% core language units at second year, plus 25% core language units at third year plus 25% second/ third year electives.
<b>History</b>	25% First year History	plus 75% second/ third year units.
<b>Indonesian</b>	25% First year Indonesian	plus 37.5% second year core language units, plus 25% core language units at third year level, plus 12.5% second/ third year elective.
<b>Japanese</b>	25% First year Japanese	Plus core units HMJ204, HMJ205, HMJ206, HMJ207 (50%), plus a minimum of 25% from HMJ306, HMJ308, HMJ311, HMJ312
<b>Journalism and Media Studies</b>	HEJ101 and HEJ102	plus HEJ209/309, LAW602 plus 50% of second/ third year units
<b>Latin</b>	HTL100	plus HTL217, HTL219, HTL220, HTL317, HTL319, HTL320
<b>Logic and Philosophy of Science</b>	Two of HPA101, HPA102, HPA181, HPA182, plus 25% first year Science subject	plus 75% of second/ third year units, with at least two units (25%) from each of List A and B.
<b>Natural Environment &amp; Wilderness Studies</b>	KGA100 or KGA101	plus 75% of second/ third year units, with at least one unit from each of List 1, 2 and 3.
<b>Philosophy</b>	Two of HPA101, HPA102, HPA181, HPA182	plus 75% second/ third year units.
<b>Political Science</b>	HSG101 and HSG102	plus 75% second/ third year units
<b>Psychology</b>	KHA101 and KHA102	plus KHA201, KHA350 plus 50% of second/ third year electives. NOTE: if considering Honours in Psych, there are additional core units and you must complete the maximum major of 150%.
<b>Public Policy</b>	HSG101 and HSG102	plus 75% of second/ third year units
<b>Sociology</b>	HGA101 and HGA102	plus HGA202, HGA203/303, plus a further 4 (50%) second/ third year units
