

Bachelor of Arts-Bachelor of Fine Arts – degree planner

The idea of this course plan is to give you a brief explanation of how this degree works and what you need to do to complete it. Once you understand what is required you can use the blank course plan overleaf to keep track of your progress.

Please note that most semester based units are weighted at 12.5%. Full year units in this degree can be weighted at 25% or 50%.

To complete the BA-BFA degree, you must pass a total of 400% of units, or 100% of units in each year of the four year degree.

In the Bachelor of Arts component you will complete 200% of units comprising:

- 50% of first year units (level 100) from the BA schedule of units
- 75% of second year units (level 200)
- 75% of third year units (level 300)
- and within the 200% of units, you must complete the requirements for one major (though there is room for two majors).
- A major (or specialisation) is made up of sequential units in one discipline, eg, Political Science, comprising 25% of (Political Science) units at level 100 (first year units) + 75% min-125% max of (Political Science) units over level 200/300 (second/third year units).

In the Bachelor of Fine Arts component you will complete 200% of units comprising:

In the Bachelor of Fine Arts component, students must complete either:

- a studio major and a minor in Art History and Cultural Theory; or
- a major in Art History and Cultural Theory and a studio minor provided that:

[1] a student completing the studio major shall normally complete 125% made up of 25% at first year, 25%-50% at second year and 50% at third year in the studio plus a minimum of 50% of units in Art and Design Theory comprising 25% at first year plus 25% at second/third year;





[2] a student completing the Art and Design Theory major shall complete 100% of Art and Design Theory units made up of 25% at first year plus 75% at second/third Year plus complete a Studio minor made up of 25% at first year, 25% at second year plus 25% at third year.
