

# **Bachelor of Arts-Bachelor of Economics – degree planner for students starting in 2006.**

## **START HERE .....**

The idea of this course plan is to give you a quick run down of how this degree works and what you need to do to complete it. Once you understand what is required you can use the blank course plan overleaf to keep track of your progress.

To complete the BA-BE degree, you must pass a total of 32 units, or 8 units in each year of the four year degree.

### **In the Bachelor of Arts component you will complete 16 units comprising:**

- 4 x 12.5% level 100 units or 2 pairs, from the BA schedule of units, normally taken in year 1
- 6 x 12.5% level 200 units, normally taken in year 2/3
- 6 x 12.5% level 300 units, normally taken in year 3/4
- and within the 16 units, you must complete the requirements for at least one major (though there is room for two majors).
- A major (or specialisation) is made up of sequential units in one discipline, eg, Political Science, comprising 2 (Political Science) units at level 100 (first year units) + 6 to 10 max of (Political Science) units over level 200/300 (second/third year units).

### **In the Bachelor of Economics component you will complete 16 units comprising:**

- 7 core units; plus
- 9 approved Economic elective units.
