START HERE

The idea of this course plan is to give you a quick run down of how the degree works and what you need to do to complete it. Once you understand what is required you can use the blank course plan overleaf to keep track of your progress.

To complete the BSocSc degree, you must pass 8 x 12.5% units at each of level 100, 200 and 300 (meaning first, second & third year). You must also complete two majors from the following list: Sociology, Human Resource Management, Political Science, Public Policy, Psychology.

A major is defined as 10 x 12.5% sequential units in one discipline (normally 2 units at level 100, and 8 units over level 200/300). Compulsory units exist within the HRM, Psychology, Sociology majors.

8 x 12.5% of first year units - made up of at least 6 units from the BSocSc Schedule, plus 2 units from either the BSocSc Schedule or from the Arts, Commerce, Law or Science Faculties.

PLUS

8 x 12.5% of second year units - made up of 4 units from one discipline for your FIRST MAJOR, plus 4 units from another discipline for your SECOND MAJOR.

PLUS

8 x 12.5% of third year units - made up of 4 units from the same discipline to complete for your FIRST MAJOR, plus 4 units from the same discipline to complete your SECOND MAJOR.
