

Bachelor of Arts-Bachelor of Economics – degree planner 2008

START HERE

The idea of this course plan is to give you a quick run down of how this degree works and what you need to do to complete it. Once you understand what is required you can use the blank course plan overleaf to keep track of your progress.

To complete the BA-BE degree, you must pass a total of 32 units, or 8 units in each year of the four year degree.

In the Bachelor of Arts component you will complete 16 units comprising:

- 4 first year units (level 100) from the BA schedule of units
- 4 second year units (level 200)
- 4 second / third year units
- 4 third year units (level 300)
- and within the 16 units, you must complete the requirements for at least one major (though there is room for two majors).
- A major (or specialisation) is made up of sequential units in one discipline, eg, Political Science, comprising 2 (Political Science) units at level 100 (first year units) + 6 to 10 max of (Political Science) units over level 200/300 (second / third year units).

In the Bachelor of Economics component you will complete 16 units comprising:

- 7 core units; plus
- 9 approved Economic elective units.
