The idea of this course plan is to give you a quick run down of how the degree works and what you need to do to complete it. Once you understand what is required, you can use the blank course plan overleaf to keep track of your progress.

To complete the BCA degree, you must pass a total of 24 units, or 8 units in each year of the 3 year degree:

- 8 compulsory first year units for one of the following streams: Theatre Studies or Two-Dimensional Studies or Three-Dimensional Studies or Theory Studies or Contemporary Music.

PLUS

- 8 second year units, depending on the stream you are taking.

PLUS

- 8 third year units, depending on the stream you are taking.
