Two different sessions are available. You are welcome to attend both sessions or just one:

The first session, *Introduction to PebblePad with a focus on eportfolios for staff*, will provide an overview of the product including a show case of professional eportfolios.

You should attend this session if:

- ✓ You are interested in developing your own professional portfolio.
- ✓ You are working in an area where you might be involved in supporting others to create professional portfolios, eg. Human Resources, Awards and Grants, etc.
- ✓ You want to get a general overview of PebblePad basics in relation to eportfolio development.
- ✓ You want to attend the *Practitioner Workshop* but have little or no experience with PebblePad.

The second session, the *Practitioner Workshop*, is designed for those who have attended the *Introduction to PebblePad* workshop and/or those who already have some understanding of PebblePad and its functions. It will be a hands-on session conducted in a computer laboratory.

- ✓ You are considering the incorporation of eportfolios into your curriculum in the future
- ✓ You want to gain a broader experience of PebblePad functionality.
