<i>Eligibility</i>	Students who have completed 2 nd year chemistry in 2009 as part of the BSc, BBiotech or BEnvSc and who agree to enrol in a major in chemistry in 2010 (BSc) or to enrol in both KRA331 and KRA332 (BBiotech) or KRA300 and KRA306 (BEnvSc)
<i>Positions</i>	4-6
<i>Location</i>	2 in Launceston, funded by Tasmanian Alkaloids 2-4 in Hobart or Launceston, funded by the School
<i>Duration</i>	Minimum of 4 weeks (not necessarily continuous); research groups may put in matching funds to extend this (eg. for a total of up to 8 weeks)
<i>Value</i>	\$350 per week tax free
<i>Timing</i>	Any period over the summer vacation suitable to both the student and the supervisor
