Editorial: Grateful thanks for our new heading* which is entirely due to Kierkegaard scholar Pater Sixtus Scholtens of Holland. Pater Sixtus has very kindly designed variations on the above heading and thanks to him we can now clearly indicate where each issue begins. – My apologies for the confusion caused last year when I sent the experimental sheet of 1979 together with the Newsletter of 1980. The system of pagination remains unchanged, see N page 5 (N = Newsletter), and as far as possible information about libraries and societies is put in alphabetical order.

Also grateful thanks for all your help and offers of help: Financial help: A big thank-you to all those who have helped finance this issue and have promised regular help for the future so that the Newsletter can continue to be free. By now personal thank-you letters will have arrived, but to be a bit more businesslike, in future there will be a proper form of receipt and each year a detailed and properly controlled statement of expenditure available. (On Nov. 10th 1981 our bank account stood at a total of 918 Danish crowns). Local distribution of the Newsletter: (xeroxing and posting copies): Very many thanks for help and offers of help in this direction. Some are sending copies whenever they encounter individual Kierkegaard interest; others have offered to act as regional printers and distributors. The result is that at present the Newsletter is going out to at least 20-22 countries all over the world. Thanks not least for information. Please keep sending it. – This year we are trying a cheaper and more efficient printing method requiring us to keep within 2 full pages. Should at any time information exceed space it will definitely appear in the next issue.

Money from abroad: For those wishing to send money to Denmark: This can be costly for both receiver and sender. Ask your bank about cheapest payment method. Note that for a direct transfer or for changing a cheque in foreign currency the receiver pays 20 crowns to the bank here. International giro is an excellent method if available. One can also send a cheque in Danish crowns if this is drawn on a Danish bank. In sending a banknote by registered post, allow the value of 7-8 crowns extra to cover the cost of changing it.
