PRICES OF BOOKS: It is regretted that it is not possible to give prices of books mentioned in the Newsletter. Not only do prices vary because of costs connected with exchanging currencies and swings in the latter, there are also big price differences according to where one buys a book. For example, David J. Gouwen's Kierkegaard's Dialectic of the Imagination costs \$38.50 U.S. + \$3.00 U.S. handling charges in the U.S. In Denmark the same book costs 414 D.kr. ordered by a bookshop through Switzerland and 214 D.kr. ordered by a bookshop through a German source. Hence one needs to ask the bookshop before one buys.
