

How do I work out my timetable?

Tips for Planning a Successful Timetable:

- **Attend the first lecture for each unit.** This is when you receive important timetable information such as how to nominate tutorial and practical class times, and when these classes begin. You may have been allocated to a practical class in your first year – it is at your first lecture that you can find out.
- Lecture times are usually set, and each session is unique - ideally you should attend every lecture.
- For some units, there may be multiple tutorial and practical class times offered each week – these are repeat classes. The online 'All Classes' timetable will display every possible tutorial or prac class time. You will generally need to choose and attend only one of these times each week.
- Consult your unit outline or the Course and Unit Handbook, <http://www.utas.edu.au/courses>, to determine which classes you need to attend.

Make sure to first **refine your search** by selecting the relevant:

- **Semester**
- **Event (class) type**
- **Campus**
- **Year**

You can display your individual timetable or that of specific units by entering either:

- **student id number** - this will display all units you are currently enrolled in.
- **unit code** that you are interested in e.g. 'KGA171'
- **multiple unit codes** - to check for clashes between unit lectures e.g. 'KPA161, KZA161, KXT101, KGA171' (select 'Lectures only')

Reading the timetable:

Unit Code: e.g. KPA161 – the unit code for Biology of Plants. Click on a unit code to see Course and Unit Handbook information about that unit.

Class types: Lecture, Tutorial, Seminar, Practical, Workshop, Field Trip or Videoconference, e.g. 'P2' would indicate Practical group 2.

Venue: e.g. NH.X.138.LT5 – tells you the campus (NH = Newnham), Building (X), room number (138, which would be on Level 1), and room type (Lecture Theatre 5) for the class. Clicking on the **venue** takes you to a more descriptive dialogue box.

Weeks: e.g. SEM1: 1-13 – this indicates that this class runs in weeks 1 to 13 – all of Semester 1.

Notes: any extra information about that class.
