

EndNote and ABC CLIO Databases

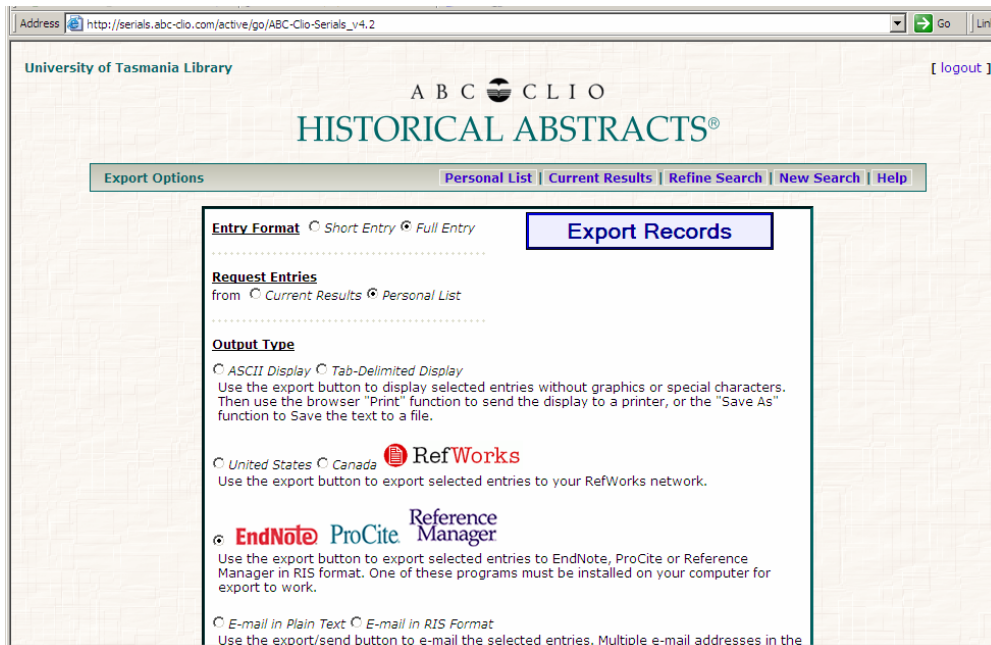
Importing records from ABC CLIO databases can be done directly without the need for an EndNote filter.

From an ABC CLIO database ...

- Perform a search
- Click on the *Check to add to Personal List* checkbox for each desired citation
- Click on the *Export Options* button. You will then be presented an *Export Records* screen

From the *Export Records* screen...

- For **Entry Format**, click on *Full entry*
- For **Request Entries**, click on *Personal List* button
- For **Output Type**, click on *EndNote, ProCite, Reference Manager* button
- Click on the *Export Records* button at top of screen. You will then be presented an *Export Manager* screen.



From the *Export Manager* screen...

- Click on the *Export to Citation Manager* button. EndNote should engage.

In EndNote...

- A *Select a Reference Library* dialogue window appears
- Select the library into where you would like the citations loaded and click *Open* (you must do this even when your library is open).

Your database records should now be loaded into your EndNote library.
