

EndNote and ACM Digital Library

Importing records from the ACM Digital Library can be done directly without the need for an EndNote filter. You can only add one reference at a time into your EndNote library. Although ACM Digital Library has fulltext documents, only brief citations will be loaded into your EndNote library. Abstracts are also excluded from your reference.

In ACM Digital Library ...

- Perform a search.
- From your list of references, click on the desired reference to see it in more detail.

NOTE:

If you wish to have the abstract added into the EndNote Library, highlight the abstract and copy the abstract (CTRL+C)

- Under the *Tools and Actions* heading click on **EndNote**.
- A new *File Download* window appears. Click on the *Open* button

In EndNote ...

- A **Select a Reference Library** dialogue window appears.
- Select the library you where you would like the references inserted and click **Open** (you must do this even when your library is already open).

Your individual database reference should now be loaded into your EndNote library.

NOTE:

To add the abstract, click on the reference loaded into your EndNote library, and paste the abstract into the Abstract field (CTRL+V)

Notes:

Always check and correct the imported citations. ACM Digital Library transfers journal titles in abbreviated form.
