

EndNote and Agricola

- Perform a search in Agricola.
- Mark the citations that you want to save.
- Select **Export Format** from the **Print Save or E-mail** box at the bottom of the screen.
- Click on **Format for Print or Save**
- Follow your browser's prompts and save the file with a **.txt** extension eg fleas.txt on your computer or disk.

Import saved records into an EndNote library

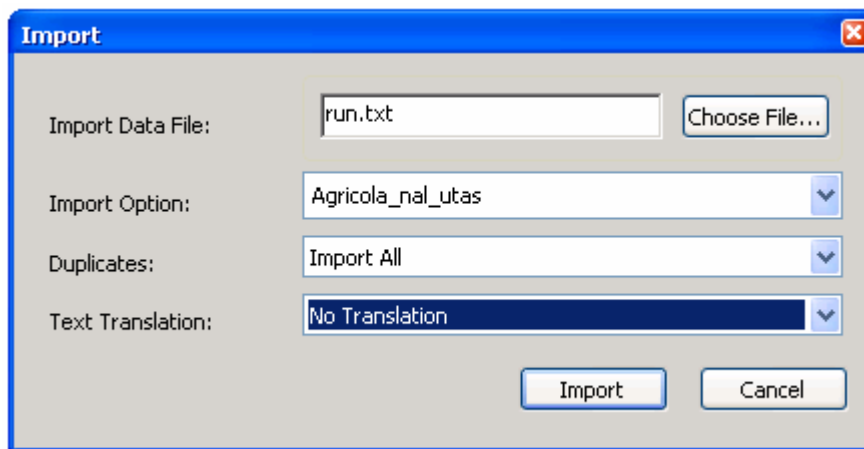
From EndNote...

- Ensure your EndNote library is open.

- Click the Import icon 

Or select **Import** from the **File** menu.

An **Import** dialogue window is opened.



- Click on **Choose File**
- Select the text file of references saved from your database search.
- From the **Import Option** pull down menu, select the filter that corresponds to the database you used.
- If the filter is not listed, click on **Other Filters**. You will be shown a list of filters select the filter you want eg. Agricola (NAL)
- Click on **Choose**.
- From the **Duplicates** pull down menu, either select **Import All** or **Discard Duplicates**.
- In the **Text Translation** box, select **No Translation**.
- Click on the **Import** button.

Your database references should now be loaded into your open EndNote library.
