

EndNote and Google Scholar


You need to configure Google Scholar to enable references to be directly imported into EndNote.

In Google Scholar. (<http://scholar.google.com>):

- Click on the **Scholar Preferences** link
- Under **Bibliography Manager** select the option **Show links to import citations into** and choose **EndNote** in the drop down box
- Click on the "**Save Preferences**" button

To import search results into EndNote:

- Perform a search in **Google Scholar**
- click on the **Import into EndNote** link for the reference you want to import (shown below)

- If you are presented with a window asking if you want to **Open** or **Save** the file, choose to **open** the file, otherwise proceed to the next step.
- A **Select a Reference Library** window will appear, use this window to select and open the EndNote library you want the reference imported into. (you must do this even when your library is already open).

Your reference should now be loaded into your EndNote library.
