


EndNote and International Index to Music Periodicals (IIMP)

Importing citations from the International Index to Music Periodicals can be done directly without the need for an EndNote filter. Although International Index to Music Periodicals has fulltext articles in its database, only brief citations will be loaded into your EndNote library.

In International Index to Music Periodicals...

- Perform a search
- Click on the *Add to Marked List* checkboxes for each desired citation
- Click the *Marked List* link at the top of the screen
- On the *Marked List* screen, click on the **Download** link. A *Marked List: Download selected items* screen is displayed

From the *Marked List: Download selected items* screen ...

- Click on the *Export directly to ProCite, EndNote or Reference Manager* link. EndNote will engage.

In EndNote...

- A *Select Reference Library* dialogue window appears
- Select the library in which you would like the citations to appear and click *Open* (you must do this even if your library is already open).

Your records should now be loaded into your EndNote library.
