

EndNote and JSTOR

Importing records from JSTOR can be done directly without the need for an EndNote filter. **However, you must first be registered as a user with the JSTOR database to save citations.**

- Perform a search in JSTOR.
- Click on the checkbox next to each desired citation on a single page of search results. Click on the **Save Citation** button to save citations marked on the page before proceeding to another page in your results list. If you have not logged in to your personal JSTOR account, you will be requested to log in
- Click on the **Saved Citations** link at the top of the screen. You are taken to a *My Saved Citations* screen
- Click on the checkboxes next to the citations you wish to import into EndNote
- Click on the **Export article citations** button. You are taken to an *Export Citations* screen

- Click on the link **EndNote**. A *File Download* dialogue window appears

From the File Download dialogue window ...

- Click on the **Open** button. EndNote will engage.

In EndNote ...

- A *Select a Reference Library* dialogue window appears
- Select the library you would like the citations put in and click **Open** (you must do this even when your library is already open).

Your database references should now be loaded into your Open EndNote library. Although JSTOR has the fulltext of articles, only brief citations will be loaded into your library.
