

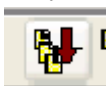
## EndNote and PubMed

- Perform a search in Medline via PubMed.
- Mark the citations that you want to save.
- From the **Display** drop down menu select **Medline**.
- From the **Send to** drop down menu select **File**
- On the **File Download** window click **Save**.
- Follow your browser's prompts and save the file with a **.txt** extension e.g. heart.txt to an appropriate place on your computer or disk.

### Importing data from your Medline text file into an EndNote Library

In EndNote...

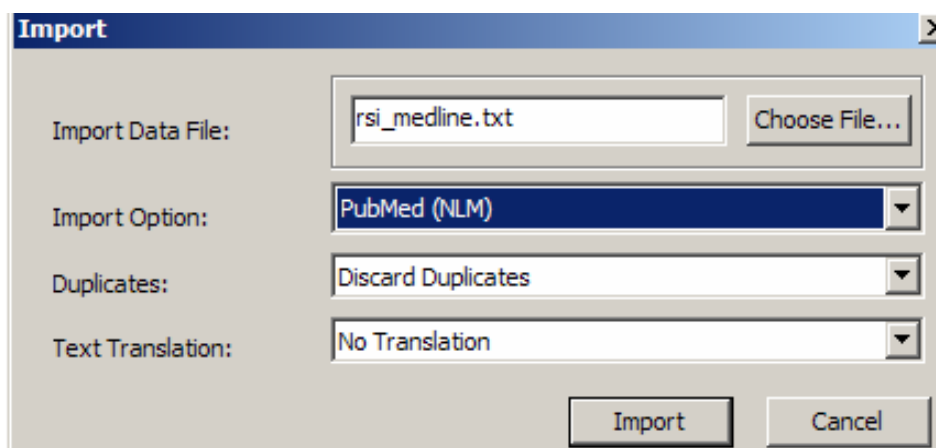
- Ensure your EndNote library is open.



- Click the Import icon

Or select **Import** from the **File** menu.

An **Import** dialogue window is opened.



- Click on the **Choose File** button.
- Select the text file of records you saved from your database search.
- From the **Import Option** drop down menu, select the **pubmed\_nlm\_utas** or **PubMed (NLM)** filter.
- If the filter is not listed click on **Other Filters**, you will be shown a list of filters available to you, select **PubMed (NLM)** or **pubmed\_nlm\_utas** then click on **Choose**.
- From the **Duplicates** pull down menu, either select **Import All** or **Discard Duplicates**.
- In the **Text Translation box**, select **No Translation**.
- Click on the **Import** button.

Your database references should now be loaded into your open EndNote library.
