

EndNote and SciFinder Scholar

In SciFinder Scholar ...

- Perform a search .
- Click in the checkboxes to mark the citations that you want to save.
- Click on the **Save As** button at the top of the screen, and a *Save File As* window appears.
- Follow your browser's prompts and create a file name, and select **Tagged format** (*.txt) from the *Save as type* dropdown menu.
- Click on **Save**.

Import saved records into an EndNote library

From EndNote...

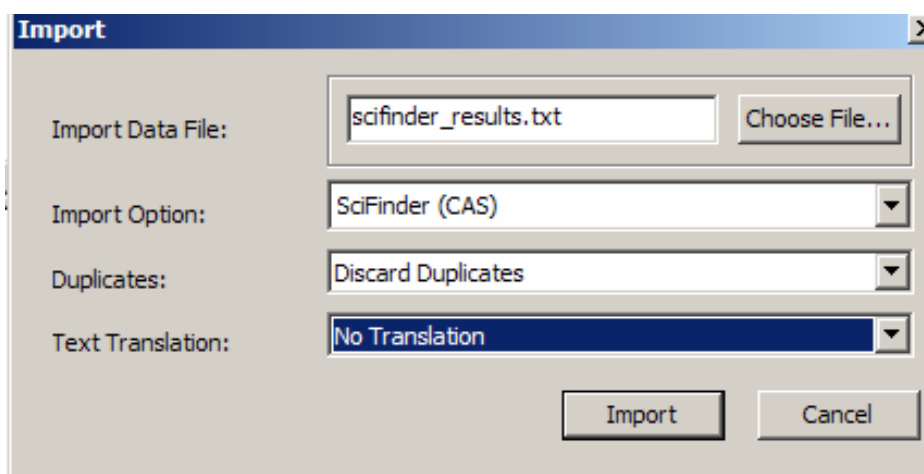
- Ensure your EndNote library is open.



- Click the Import icon

Or select **Import** from the **File** menu.

An **Import** dialogue window is opened.



- Click on **Choose File**
- Select the text file of references saved from your database search.
- From the **Import Option** pull down menu, select SciFinder (CAS) filter.
- If the filter is not listed, click on **Other Filters**. You will be shown a list of filters and select Scifinder (CAS). Click on **Choose**.
- From the **Duplicates** pull down menu, either select **Import All** or **Discard Duplicates**.
- In the **Text Translation** box, select **No Translation**.
- Click on the **Import** button.

Your database references should now be loaded into your open EndNote library.
