


## EndNote and Wiley InterScience

Importing records from Wiley InterScience can be done directly without the need for an EndNote filter. Although Wiley InterScience contains the fulltext of articles, only brief citations will be loaded into your EndNote Library.

### In Wiley InterScience ...

- Perform a search.
- Mark the citations you want to save by clicking the checkbox against the desired citations
- Click on the button **Download Selected Citations** at the bottom of the results list. A Citation *Export* window appears
- From the **Format** dropdown menu, select **EndNote**
- From the **Export Type** dropdown menu, select **Citation**
- **From the File Type** dropdown menu, select your computer type
- Click on the button **Go**. A *File Download* dialogue window appears

- Click on the button **Open**. EndNote will engage.

### In EndNote ...

- A **Select a Reference Library** dialogue window appears.
- Select the library you would like the citations put in and click **Open** (you must do this even when your library is already open).

Your database records should now be loaded into your EndNote library. Check your imported references as they will require some editing. If you require abstracts, copy and paste the abstracts into the EndNote citations. The Export Type option **Citation and abstract** in Wiley InterScience does not import all marked records.
