## Scholarship Information

### Short-term overseas study 2009/2010

#### Conditions

- 1 To be eligible, students must be enrolled in one of the School's language programs in Indonesia or Japan. Students should also have no outstanding University debts, eg. S & A fees.
- 2 The scholarships are to assist overseas study in short-term, intensive courses.
- 3 Students must complete the attached application form.
- 4 A selection committee consisting of the Head of School and a representative from each of the disciplines sponsoring the programs will meet to decide the successful students.
- 5 Applicants will be assessed on the information provided in the application form.
- 6 Successful students will be notified by e-mail to their UTAS account.
- 7 While studying overseas students are required to meet all requirements of the host institution regarding study, such as attendance at lectures/tutorials and completion of assessment tasks. Students attend these programs as representatives of the School and the University and as such are expected to maintain a high standard of behaviour.
- 8 If a student fails to take up the overseas study option they must repay the funds received to the School. In such cases, repayment is expected to be made before the relevant program commences.
- 9 A student can only receive one School short-term overseas study scholarship during the course of their major.
- 10 A student in receipt of a Faculty of Arts overseas study scholarship is not eligible for a School of Asian Languages overseas study scholarship as well.
