

ORDINANCE NO. 10

Ordinance Of Emeritus Professors

(last updated 26 July 1991)

The Council of the University of Tasmania in pursuance of and in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by the *Higher Education (Amalgamation) Act 1990* hereby makes the following Ordinance.

1. The Emeritus Professors of the University shall be:
 - (a) those persons upon whom that title was conferred pursuant to Statutes made under the *Tasmanian University Act 1951*; and
 - (b) those persons upon whom that title is conferred pursuant to this Ordinance.
2. The Council may confer the title of Professor Emeritus on any professor of the University on or after resignation or retirement, in recognition of services to the University.
3. In considering whether a professor shall receive the title of Professor Emeritus the Council shall take into account services rendered to any one or both of the University of Tasmania (whether before or after the repeal of the *Tasmanian University Act, 1951*) and the Council of Advanced Education.
4. A Professor Emeritus shall for all purposes of courtesy and on ceremonial occasions be regarded as a professor of the University.
5. This Ordinance comes into force on 26 July, 1991.
