

ORDINANCE NO. 4

DEPUTY VICE-CHANCELLORS, PRO VICE-CHANCELLORS AND SENIOR ADMINISTRATORS

The Council of the University of Tasmania makes this Ordinance under the University of Tasmania Act 1992.

1 Commencement and revocation

- 1.1 This ordinance takes effect on 1 December 2002.
- 1.2 Ordinance 6 (Of the Deputy Vice-Chancellors and Deputy Principals) and Ordinance 93 (Head of Finance and Administration) are revoked.

2 Deputy Vice-Chancellors

- 2.1 Council may, on the advice of the Vice-Chancellor, appoint any Deputy Vice-Chancellors that the Council decides, for the periods and on the conditions that Council determines.
- 2.2 A Deputy Vice-Chancellor is to assist the Vice-Chancellor in the execution of the duties of the Vice-Chancellor, and has any additional duties that the Council or the Vice-Chancellor determines.
- 2.3 A Deputy Vice-Chancellor is by position a Professor of the University.

3 Pro Vice-Chancellors

- 3.1 Council may, on the advice of the Vice-Chancellor, appoint any Pro Vice-Chancellors that the Council decides, for the periods and on the conditions that Council determines.
- 3.2 A Pro Vice-Chancellor is to assist the Vice-Chancellor in the execution of the academic and executive duties of the Vice-Chancellor, and has any additional duties that the Council or the Vice-Chancellor determines.
- 3.3 A Pro Vice-Chancellor is by position a Professor of the University.

4 Senior Administrators

- 4.1 Council may, on the advice of the Vice-Chancellor, appoint any Senior Administrators that the Council decides, for the period and on the conditions that Council determines.
- 4.2 A Senior Administrator is to assist the Vice-Chancellor in the execution of the administrative duties of the Vice-Chancellor, and has any additional duties that the Council or the Vice-Chancellor determines.
- 4.3 The Executive Director Finance and Administration is a Senior Administrator.

5 Transitional provisions

- 5.1 The current terms of office as
- Deputy Vice-Chancellor of Professor Rudi Lidl (until 31 December 2003)
 - Pro Vice-Chancellor (Research) of Professor Andrew Glenn (until 20 September 2003)
 - Pro Vice-Chancellor (Teaching and Learning) of Professor Sue Johnston (until 28 January 2006)
 - Executive Director Finance and Administration of Mr Tony Ferrall (until 2 December 2006)
- continue, despite this ordinance, until the relevant dates indicated in this clause, on the terms and conditions in force immediately before this ordinance takes effect.

6 Alternative titles for Deputy Vice-Chancellors and Pro Vice-Chancellors

- 6.1 A Deputy Vice-Chancellor may use any of these titles –
- Deputy Vice-Chancellor
 - Deputy Vice-Chancellor and Vice-President
 - Vice-President
- that a particular context or occasion requires.
- 6.2 A Pro Vice-Chancellor may use any of these titles –
- Pro Vice-Chancellor
 - Pro Vice-Chancellor and Vice-President
 - Vice-President
- that a particular context or occasion requires.
