

ORDINANCE NO. 95

ACTING VICE-CHANCELLOR

The Council of the University of Tasmania makes this Ordinance under the University of Tasmania Act 1992.

1 Commencement

1.1 This ordinance takes effect on 15 March 2002.

2 Deputy Vice-Chancellor or Pro Vice-Chancellor may be appointed as Acting Vice-Chancellor

2.1 During the absence or incapacity of the Vice-Chancellor, the Deputy Vice-Chancellor or Pro Vice-Chancellor who is appointed in writing by the Vice-Chancellor for the purpose shall become Acting Vice-Chancellor.

2.2 The authority of the Vice-Chancellor is not affected by a Deputy Vice-Chancellor or Pro Vice-Chancellor becoming Acting Vice-Chancellor.

2.3 If the Vice-Chancellor fails to make the appointment authorised by clause 2.1, or if there is a vacancy in the office of the Vice-Chancellor, the Chancellor may appoint in writing a Deputy Vice-Chancellor or Pro Vice-Chancellor to be Acting Vice-Chancellor.

2.4 Any appointment of a Deputy Vice-Chancellor or Pro Vice-Chancellor to be Acting Vice-Chancellor may be revoked or altered by Council.

3 Validation of previous appointments

3.1 Despite Ordinance 6, any written appointment of a Pro Vice-Chancellor as Acting Vice-Chancellor that the Vice-Chancellor purported to make before 15 March 2002 is deemed always to have been validly made.

3.2 Any action of a Pro Vice-Chancellor in purported exercise of authority as Acting Vice-Chancellor under an appointment made before 15 March 2002 is deemed always to have had the same force and effect for all purposes as it would have if the appointment had been made under clause 2.1.

4 Amendment of Ordinance 6

4.1 Clause 3 of Ordinance 6 is revoked.
