For the first time, the annual University of Tasmania Open Day is being presented as an immersive virtual series, specifically designed to showcase the State.

It will commence tomorrow, **(Friday 28 August)** and continue on Saturday 29 August and Sunday 30 August, taking place between 10am – 5pm each day.

Michelle Weir, Executive Director of Marketing said more than 3600 people had already registered for the online experience.

"Open Day is all about bringing our distinctive learning and research opportunities to life," Ms Weir said.

"It is a chance for the community to ask our students and staff their questions, gather information to help guide their educational journey, and develop an authentic sense of what studying with us is really like.

"The virtual platform will immerse visitors into live events, tours of Tasmania and take them right into the heart of our existing and future campuses.
