## Course delivery

**Fully online units:** CAM503, CAM619, CAA500, KHB701

**Units with practical face to face elements:** CAM630, CAM631, CAM632, CAM634, CAM635

**CAM632 Humans in Space** is a collaborative venture with the [Australasian Society of Aerospace Medicine](#) and has a mixed delivery format as a Semester 2 availability.

The central feature is a residential course run by ASAM and held in Melbourne, with online material and activities both prior to, and after, the course. Only enrol in CAM632 if you are able to attend the residential course. NOTE: that the unit fee is higher than the default fee and covers the cost of this workshop.

### CAM631 Expedition Medicine

These eight day intensive and practical residential courses are offered in partnership with the Australian Antarctic Division as stand-alone courses for CPD or as an elective unit.

#### Timing of CAM631 enrolment

1. Complete the July course and enrol in CAM631 in Semester 2 to complete the online assessment **OR**
2. Complete the December course and enrol in CAM631 in Semester 1 of the following year to complete the online assessment.

### CAM634 Extreme Sports Medicine (Pre-req unit is CAM619)

This unit uses a mixed delivery format and includes a 3 day compulsory workshop in Hobart in August. Only enrol in CAM634 if you are able to attend the residential course. Note that the unit fee is higher than the default fee and covers the cost of this workshop. **CAM635 Medical Care for Offshore and Inland Waters**

These eight day intensive and practical residential courses are offered in partnership with the Australian Antarctic Division as stand-alone courses for CPD or as an elective unit. Both the course and the subsequent unit assessment are to be completed during semester 1.
