1.

Registering for a scholarship account and applying for scholarship(s) are two separate steps. After your account registration is completed, don't forget to apply for scholarships.

2.

Be sure to read every question carefully as the data you enter will determine which scholarships are available to you when using the search tool.

3.

Some fields in the form become non-editable after the submission, such as gender, citizenship, name, and proxy. If you need to change them, please email us at scholarships.office@utas.edu.au

4.

If the "Find a scholarship" search brings you 0 results, untick filtering criteria to see more options.

5.

Ensure you enter the correct address as a number of scholarships is based on your residential address before you relocate to be closer to campus (if applicable).

6.

Save your scholarship application often and don't leave it without any activity for longer than 30 minutes.
