Dear Parent/Guardian,

My name is I am a pre-service teacher enrolled in an initial teacher education course at the University of Tasmania. I plan to be working with your child during my Professional Experience placement. Duty of care for your child is maintained by my supervising teacher(s) throughout the placement.

As part of the expectations of my studies and the placement, I would like to use data about your child to inform my teaching practice and to promote your child's learning. The school's principal would also be happy to explain how the school manages student data ethically and confidentially.
