Subject: Privacy law review

Hi Jeremy,

There are 2 Acts which need updating.

One is the Crown Lands Act, the other is the one governing MAST.

In the Land Titles Act there is an exemption from the Privacy Act to allow searches of property records. This aids the efficiency in the transfer of land and helps ensure property is subject to competition to find its 'highest and best use'.

MAST used to have names of mooring owners on the list database but took them out about 10 years ago rather than insert the exemption. This leads to inefficiency in the use of moorings and prevents the ready identification of mooring owners and lessees.

I think you'll find the same problem with crown leases and licences..
