The stipend can be used for travel, accommodation or research materials

This bursary is awarded twice each year. Applications close on June 30 and Nov 1 each year. Applications should include a brief literature review, the aims of the research, how the bursary is to be spent, the likely outputs and the benefits to the country where the research is undertaken.

Where there is more than one application, members of the SOM Internationalisation Committee will adjudicate the successful applicant.

NB All research projects conducted in low resource countries need to receive ethics approval from the relevant UTAS ethics committee and the country where the research is being conducted.
