Collaborate 15 – Ultra View



Blackboard Collaborate is the Web conferencing Software used at UTAS

- Web Conferencing enables you to connect with staff and students using voice, text chat, webcam, whiteboard tools and shared applications over the Internet.
- We are currently on version 12.6
- Version 12.6 system relies on the use of Java, and requires staff and students to download a Collab file before the system can be used.
- Blackboard Collaborate is the cause of one the highest percentages of student and staff jobs to the MyLO Support team



Collaborate 15 – Ultra View



Collaborate 15 is the new version available from June. UTAS will continue to have access to both versions allowing users the option to pilot Ultra View.

With Ultra View:

- The new system has been redeveloped to be HTML 5 compliant and no longer reliant on Java for end users. It is based on Web RTC technology.
- No longer need to download the collab launcher.
- New modern interface. Much simpler to use in its redesign. Must Use Google Chrome for full functionality
- Introduction of new role: presenter
 - Moderator has full functionality and control over the web room
 - Presenter can present/deliver presentations and perform activities associated with that (e.g. whiteboard, share screen, share application)
 - Student normal role as per what's available now, cannot deliver presentations but can interact with features made available in room.



Release time lines for Ultra View



Release 1: Early June (now available)

- 50 user cap on rooms
- no recording functionality
- no breakout rooms
- no integrations with D2L


Release 2: End of June

- 100 user cap on rooms
- Recording available Will be automatically converted into MP4 format
- LTI integration Which will allow integration with D2L (not through Online Rooms)
- Blackboard student APP for mobile devices that will work with collaborate


Easy Voice/ Webcam set up

You can do this later, but you will need to do it at least once in order to use audio in future sessions.






Video sharing




- Easy to set up
